

## Thomas J. Ninnie February 18, 1954 - July 6, 2020

Thomas J. Ninnie, devoted husband, father and grandfather, died July 6, peacefully at home surrounded by his loving and adoring family after a brief battle with Pancreatic Cancer. He was 66.
